REGULATIONS OF PGDYT (Regular): DURATION:

The duration of the course leading to the Post Graduate Diploma in Yoga Therapy shall be **ONE YEAR** (2 Semesters) and **THREE MONTHS** compulsory internship (After completion of the course).

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

A person who has done **Graduation with 50% marks** from Panjab University or from any other University whose examination has been recognized as equivalent to the corresponding examination (under 10+2+3 system of education) of this University shall be eligible to join the Diploma Course; preference will be given to the students having any recognized course in yoga and reservation shall be provided as per the Rules and Regulation of the University.

INTAKE:

Proposed number of seats for one unit is 25.

RESERVATION OF SEATS:

Reservation in seats shall be provided as per the Rules and Regulation of the Chandigarh Administration/Panjab University.

REGULATIONS OF BCCYE (Part Time): DURATION:

The duration of the course leading to the Basic Certificate Course in Yoga Education (Part Time) shall be **SIX MONTHS** (Evening Classes 5:00 p.m. onwards).

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

i) FOR REGULAR STUDENTS

Any student enrolled in a regular degree course in an affiliated college/Panjab University department with at least **45% MARKS IN +2** from any recognized board/institute.

ii) FOR GENERAL PUBLIC (EMPLOYEES ALSO)

Any Indian citizen with a **GRADUATION** degree at least **45% MARKS** from any recognized university.

iii) FOR FOREIGN NATIONALS

Only **TWO SEATS** over and above to the foreign nationals having valid visa and permission from all agencies as per government and University norms and possessing **GRADUATION** degree with at least **45% MARKS** or equivalent grade from a recognized University/ Institute.

INTAKE:

Proposed number of seats for one unit is 20+2.

RESERVATION OF SEATS:

Reservation in seats shall be provided as per the Rules and Regulation of the Chandigarh Administration/Panjab University.
